A. On the computer:

1. From the **System** pull-down choose **Help and Support**
2. Within an application such as **OpenOffice.org Writer**, from the Help pull-down menu choose **OpenOffice.org Help**.

B. Internet:

1. Ubuntu.com - Ubuntu Community Support
2. OpenOffice.org - Anything related to the OpenOffice.org package of applications such as Writer, Calc, Presentation
3. google.com - Search for just about anything using the search box. Typical example: suppose you want to learn how to make a CD-R data disk. In the google.com search box write without the quotes: "Ubuntu make a CD-R data disk" You should find a number of links to pages that discuss and show the steps of the process.
